

KEVIN JOHNSON – BIOGRAPHY

Kevin Johnson is the CEO of Secure Ideas, a Jacksonville-based independent security consulting and penetration testing firm focused on providing organizations with the services and knowledge needed to improve the security posture of their computing and network environment. He has a long history in the IT field including system administration, network architecture and application development. He has been involved in building incident response and forensic teams, architecting security solutions for large enterprises and penetration testing everything from government agencies to Fortune 100 companies.

Kevin is very involved in the open source community, running a number of open source projects including SamuraiWTF; a web pen-testing environment, Laudanum; a collection of injectable web payloads and Yokoso; an infrastructure fingerprinting project.

Using various war stories from decades of experience, we will explain how the attacker views the user, and what they do to increase the success rate of these attacks.
